Resubmission of Amended Labeling Dated June 14, 1995

Dear Mr. Marshall,

We have reviewed the labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, and pursuant to PR Notice 94-7. The subject amended labeling is acceptable provided that you:

1. Amend the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" section as indicated below.
 - a. Under "USE RESTRICTIONS", combine the first two sentences into one complete sentence and separate the last two sentences into a separate paragraph as indicated below.

"This product may be used to control Norway rats, roof rats, and house mice in and around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings and similar man-made structures, and in sewers."

"Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Do not broadcast bait."

- b. Under "APPLICATION DIRECTIONS" for MICE, add "to appear" at the end of the last sentence.
 - c. Under "APPLICATION DIRECTIONS" for RATS, add a period at the end of the second paragraph.

2. Change the "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" statement to read

"This product is toxic to mammals and birds. Do not apply this product directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark."

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- 3. Amend the "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" statement as indicated below.
 - a. If your product is intended for both commercial and household uses, change the "PESTICIDE DISPOSAL" and "CONTAINER DISPOSAL" directions to read

"PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:

Commercial use: Wastes resulting from the use of this product should be securely wrapped in several layers of newspaper and then disposed of onsite or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Household use: Securely wrap wastes resulting from the use of this product in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash."

"CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

Commercial use: Dispose of empty container in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Household use: Do not reuse container. Wrap container securely in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash."


- b. If your product is intended either solely for commercial use or solely for household use, the label must only include the appropriate commercial or household disposal directions under "PESTICIDE DISPOSAL" and "CONTAINER DISPOSAL".

- 4. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. We caution you to refrain from adding any claims or directions to the final printed label that were not part of the stamped accepted label.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS:
It is a violation of Federal law inconsistent with its labeling. **READ THIS LABEL:** Read directions and use precautions. **IMPORTANT:** Do not expose animals to rodenticides. To help

1. Store product not in use in a kitchen or near pets.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of animals and nontarget wildlife, such as bait stations. These stations must be placed in a manner that prevents access by dogs and by children under six years of age. Bait stations must be placed in compartments and obtained by keys or other means when they are lifted, used, or otherwise immobilized. Even in areas open to hoofed livestock, bait stations should be placed in potentially destructive animals.
3. Dispose of product container, unused bait, and bait stations.

USE RESTRICTIONS:
For Control of Norway rats, roof rats, and house mice, this product may be used in sewers where there is a possibility of contamination. Do not allow direct contact with food. Do not

SELECTION OF TREATMENT:
Norway rats and/or mice will most likely be found in burrows. Generally, these are along walls, in corners and concealed burrows, in corners and concealed burrows, or in locations where rodents or mice are present. Bait from rain or snow. Remove bait when possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:
Each ROZOL PARAFFIN BLOCK should be broken into eight 2-oz pieces. **MICE:** Break block and apply in small space placements at intervals. Space placements at intervals to allow uninterrupted supply of fresh bait. Mouse activity ceases.

RATS: Apply two to eight 2-oz pieces at each placement location. Space placements in infested areas. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 10 days or until fresh signs of rats are observed.

For burrow applications, insert bait into each active burrow. Check burrows regularly to make sure that bait is being consumed.

For sewer applications, section off sewer line and place ROZOL PARAFFIN BLOCKS in the sewer line. Allow the bottom step of a manhole to allow just enough wire for benching. If benching is not possible, place the blocks 12 inches above the high water mark. The blocks are supported by opposing steps. Remove the blocks by rats or water. Place blocks in the sewer line. **RATS/MICE:** Replace bait containers and properly dispose of any bait that has become stale. Prevent reinfestation, limit access to harborage as much as possible. Where a continuous infestation exists, establish permanent bait stations.
