RANGELANDS

RESTRICTIONS FOR USE FOR CONTROL OF PRAIRIE DOGS: Use RIDALL-ZINC to control Blacktailed Prairie Dogs (*Cynomys ludovicianus*) and Whitetailed Prairie Dogs (*C. leucurus*) on rangelands in western U.S. (Colorado, Montana, Arizona, New Mexico, Wyoming, Texas, Oklahoma, Kansas, Nebraska, North & South Dakota).

BAITING: Use a prebait of one teaspoon of untreated rolled oats placed near each active mound 2-4 days before using RIDALL-ZINC bait. This will increase prairie dog acceptance of the bait. When 50% of the prebait is eaten, hand bait using one teaspoon of bait placed within a one foot radius of each mound entrance. The recommended baiting time is from July to December with only one application each year. Bury the uneaten bait or dead animals found.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by Storage or Disposal.

STORAGE: Store in original container only in a locked storage area inaccessible to children and pets
