Do not use this product in the present occupied range of the Atwater's prairie chicken in the following Texas counties: Aransas, Austin, Brazoria, Colorado, Dewitt, Fort Bend, Galveston, Goliad, Harris, Refugio, Victoria, Waller and Wharton.
- **UTAH: Utah Prairie Dog** (*Cynomys parvidens*). Do not use this product in the range of the Utah prairie dog.

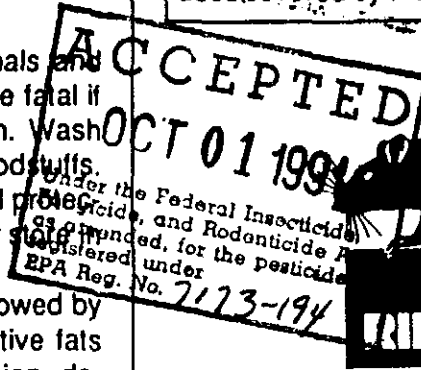
