This product is toxic to wildlife and fish. Birds and other wildlife feeding on treated bait may be killed. Do not apply to open ground, roads and areas in which no vegetation occurs. Pick up and properly dispose of all spilled toxic bait. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds and aquatic systems. Do not apply where runoff from this product will enter an aquatic system. Check for and dispose of excess spoiled bait and carcasses daily until the bait is expended or removed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in original container only in a locked storage area inaccessible to children and pets.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE DIRECTIONS: Use RIDALL-ZINC to control Norway Rats (*Rattus norvegicus*), Roof Rats (*R. rattus*) and House Mice (*Mus musculus*) in and around homes, agricultural and commercial buildings, and other manmade structures. The bait must be placed in bait boxes. Do not use RIDALL-ZINC in places where it may be possible to contaminate food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food.

SELECT GOOD TREATMENT PLACES: Before baiting, remove available sources of food for rodents and locate free places to apply bait. Do not use food utensils to apply bait. Put bait in areas frequented by rats and mice such as along walls, near burrows, in corners, under floors, or other places where rodent signs are evident.

DIRECTIONS FOR NORWAY RAT AND ROOF RAT CONTROL: Apply 1 or 2 tablespoons (8-15 grams) of RIDALL-ZINC bait per bait point in tamperproof bait boxes. Keep an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait until rodent signs and feeding stop. Apply bait at 30-day intervals when required for rat control.

DIRECTIONS FOR HOUSE MOUSE CONTROL: Apply 1 teaspoon (4 grams) of RIDALL-ZINC bait at 15-foot intervals. If used outside build up, make certain to protect the bait from weather. Maintain an uninterrupted bait supply until the mouse infestation subsides. Apply bait at 30-day intervals.
