

  - In the second sentence of the "RESTRICTIONS FOR USE" portion of the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE", insert "nontarget" between "and" and "wildlife".
- We were unable to locate any acute dermal, acute inhalation, eye irritation, dermal irritation, or dermal sensitization studies supporting this product. Additional label revisions may be required following the citation or submission of outstanding acute study data during reregistration.
- Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
