The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/ reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. On the center panel of the proposed label, change "RESTRICTED-USE PESTICIDE" to "RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE".
 - b. The statement "This Rodenticide is Dangerous to Warm-Blooded Animals" should read "This Rodenticide is Harmful to Warm-Blooded Animals" and be moved to the end of the precautionary statements.
 - c. In the second sentence of the "RESTRICTIONS FOR USE" portion of the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE", insert "nontarget" between "and" and "wildlife".
3. We were unable to locate any acute dermal, acute inhalation, eye irritation, dermal irritation, or dermal sensitization studies supporting this product. Additional label revisions may be required following the citation or submission of outstanding acute study data during reregistration.
4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Use **RIDALL-ZINC TRACKING POWDER** to control the House Mouse in agricultural and industrial structures. **RIDALL-ZINC TRACKING POWDER** is not accessible to children and wildlife. If using in buildings where lives of commercial food service food processing establishments to concealed, inaccessible spaces between floor joists, tracking powder along floor areas of rooms handled or stored. Do not use **TRACKING POWDER** in areas where it is possible to contaminate food in contact with food. Do not use in ventilation duct openings.

SELECTION OF APPLICATION AREAS

Locate dry, acid-free places for application. Do not allow mice to pass and walk over application areas. Good places for application are walls, under floors, in cracks, and in other places. Locate mouse signs and use **TRACKING POWDER** and bait devices to guide mice.

DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATION

Carefully and evenly apply 1-2 teaspoons of **TRACKING POWDER** about 5 x 20 inches in size. Scatter this material, through a hole, in the particles adhering to the surface. Use **TRACKING POWDER** for at least 30 days. A minimum of 30 days is required for treating the same area. Dispose of **TRACKING POWDER** in containers in a
