Dear Ms. Robey,

Thank you for your submission of the revised labeling for the subject product to comply with Pesticide Regulation Notice 93-1, which requires registrants of restricted use products to indicate the reason the products are restricted.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Change the phrase, "DUE TO HIGH ACUTE TOXICITY" which you added after "RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE" to "DUE TO ACUTE ORAL TOXICITY". That is the criterion that is specified for Zinc Phosphide products with this formulation and level of the active ingredient, and for this type of use, in 40 CFR § 152.175.
2. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

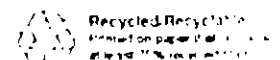

Use Ridall-Zinc Tracking Powder for House Mice (Mu) only in residential, commercial, institutional, natural and industrial structures. Ridall-Zinc Tracking Powder is not accessible to children, pets, or nontarget wildlife. Do not use in natural buildings where the product is accessible in commercial food processing or food storage areas. Do not use in spaces between floor joists. Do not use tracking powder in areas where it will be handled or stored. Do not use Tracking Powder in places where it will contaminate food or food contact surfaces with food. Do not use in duct openings.

SELECTION OF APPLICATION

Locate dry, acid-free, unobstructed places for applying powder. Use board guide mice over traps.

DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATION

Carefully and evenly apply 2 to 3 teaspoons of tracking powder in a 20 inch by 20 inch area. Do not apply material, through natural openings, or articles adhering to the floor. Do not der for at least 25 days. Do not mumm of 30 days in the same area again. Do not pose of dead mice in a safe manner.
