USE RESTRICTIONS

For control of Norway rats, Roof rats

Urban Areas: May be used at the periphery of homes, industrial, commercial

Maki may also be used in and around buildings (train, aircraft) and related port or terminal areas used in alleys.

Nonurban Areas: May be used in agricultural buildings.

Treated baits must be placed in temporary locations not accessible to children, pets, and wildlife. Do not place baits in areas where they may contaminate food surfaces that come in contact with food.

Selection of Treatment Areas

Choose areas where rats and/or mice will most readily consume bait. Generally, these areas are in concealed places, between floors and walls, where rodents or their signs have been observed as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

Rats: Place 3 to 16 pieces of bait (at intervals of 15 to 30 feet) per room to ensure uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for activity cease.

Mice: Place 1 piece of Maki mini block per placement. Two pieces may be placed in high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply for 15 days or until signs of mouse activity cease.

Replace contaminated or spoiled bait. If infestation does occur, eliminate food, water, and nesting material. If infestation is persistent, continuous source of infestation is present and replenish as needed.
