STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention at once.

Repeat-d doses may need to be given for up to two weeks (based on monitoring of prothrombin times). In severe cases, blood transfusions may be necessary.
