On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

This product is unconditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5).

Make the following changes to the labeling of the subject product before you release it for shipment:

1. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 7173-205".
2. Modify the heading "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:" so that it occurs on a line all by itself, does not end with a colon (":"), and is centered. The subheading "HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS" must begin on the line immediately below the line on which "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" occurs and should be the only text on the line(s) on which it occurs.
3. Change the Signal Word to "WARNING" on both the left and center panels of the label. This change is required because the accepted ("Guideline") Primary Eye Irritation study (MRID No. 426280-01) we have on file for Generation Pellets produced moderate irritation, leading to a Toxicity Category II classification of the study results. This change is required even though all other Acute Toxicology study results require only a "CAUTION" Signal Word.

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- 4. For the same reason the change in item 3. is needed, modify the second paragraph in the "HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS" subsection to read as follows:

"Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear safety glasses. Wash arms, hands, and face thoroughly with soap and water after applying and before eating and smoking. **If swallowed, call a physician at once.**"

You must submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If the final printed labeling is not received prior to shipment of this product, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these requirements.

Your proposal to change the name of this product from Halt Pellets to Generation Pellets is acceptable.

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ THIS LABEL: Read directions and use precautions.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose to rodenticides. To help to prevent:

1. Store product not in use in a kitchen.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, domestic animals, and nontarget wildlife. These stations must be resistant to tampering by children under six years of age, and must be secured to prevent access by such children from reaching into the bait container. If bait can be shaken from station, it must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Stations must be secured in areas open to household pets and other potentially destructive animals.

3. Dispose of product container as specified on this label.

USE RESTRICTIONS: For use in residential areas to control House Mice.

URBAN AREAS: This product may be used in residential, commercial, and industrial areas. It may also be used in transport vehicles around related port or terminal buildings must be made in tanks, the walls or other external parts (loading docks) where rats or mice are present.

NON URBAN AREAS: agricultural buildings.

Do not place bait in areas where food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where rats or mice are present. Generally, these are corners and concealed places where rodents or their signs are present. Remove alternative food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:
RATS: Apply 3 to 16 ounces of bait per 100 square feet. An uninterrupted supply of fresh bait should be maintained until activity ceases.

MICE: Apply 1/4 to 1/2 ounce of bait per 100 square feet. An uninterrupted supply of fresh bait should be maintained until activity ceases.

RATS AND MICE: Repeat treatment immediately. Collect and dispose of bait properly. To prevent food, water, and harborage as possible. If activity occurs, repeat treatment. When activity ceases, establish permanent bait stations.
