Dear Ms. Rahn,

Your application for amended registration for EPA Reg. No. 7173-210, dated June 13, 1997, has been reviewed. Your proposal to add a modified single-feeding claim for house mice to the outer container label for this product is basically acceptable provided that you revise your proposed outer container label as indicated below.

Because this product is claimed to control only one type of rodent (the house mouse), you must change the word "RODENTS" to "MICE" in the single-feeding claim on your final printed label. In addition, because no fold-out label for the bait station itself was submitted, we require that no changes be made to that part of the labeling and that the label used for the individual stations be identical to the label that we accepted on December 24, 1996.

Please submit one copy of your final printed label for the outer container before you release the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended label constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
