Rats/Mice: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait, and any bait that has become accessible to nontarget animals. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish bait as needed.
