**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**READ THIS LABEL:** Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions.

**IMPORTANT:** Do not expose children, pets or other nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help to prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals, and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hoofed livestock, raccoons, bears, other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product container, unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

**USE RESTRICTIONS:** For control of Norway Rats, Roof Rats and House Mice.

**URBAN AREAS:** This product may be used in and around homes, and industrial, commercial, and public buildings. This product may also be used in transport vehicles (ships, trains, aircraft) and in and around related port or terminal buildings. All applications "around" buildings must be made in tamper-resistant bait stations placed along the walls or other external parts of buildings (e.g., doorways, ramps, loading docks) where rats or mice might seek to gain entrance.

**NON URBAN AREAS:** May be used inside of homes and agricultural buildings.

Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food.

**SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS:**

Determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are along walls, by ground openings, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:**

**RATS:** Apply 6 to 23 blocks per placement. Placements usually should be spaced at intervals of 15 to 30 feet. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 10 days or until signs of rat activity cease.

**MICE:** Apply 1 block per placement. Space placements at 8- to 12-foot intervals. Larger amounts (up to 2 blocks) may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 15 days or until signs of mouse activity cease.

**RATS AND MICE:** Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all visible dead animals and leftover bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish bait as needed.
