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2. On your proposed revised labeling submitted March 19, 1997 make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment.
- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 7173-219.
  - b. Add the following statement of treatment for inhalation exposure to the "First Aid" instructions, in between the statements for "If on Skin" and "If in Eyes":  
  
"If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention."
  - c. On the left panel of your proposed label, the statement "**HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**" should be left-justified so it is clear that this is a subheading subordinate to the heading "**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS.**" Also, delete the "S" in "**HAZARDS.**"
  - d. The text under "**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**" must be revised to read as follows:  
  
"**WARNING:** Keep away from humans, domestic animals, and pets. May be fatal if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Do not breathe dust. Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse. Exposure to this product during pregnancy should be avoided."  
  
Please note that the revised text under "**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**" will consist of one paragraph, and that the entire third paragraph on your proposed label, beginning with "In case of contact with skin...", must be deleted.
  - e. Below the "**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN**" section, add an emergency telephone number to call for specialized medical advice.
  - f. Under "**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**," amend the "**STORAGE**" statement to read:  
  
"**STORAGE:** Avoid exposure to freezing temperatures. Store only in original container in an area inaccessible to children and pets. Do not store near food or feed."  
  
The two sentences of instructions on your proposed label beginning with "In case of spillage..." should be deleted as they are not appropriate for a dry concentrate/solid or powder formulation.

3. Submit two copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
4. The acute inhalation (81-3) and dermal sensitization (81-6) studies (MRIDs 443158-01 and 442433-01) you submitted March 20, 1997 have been reviewed and are considered acceptable. The acute toxicity database for your product is now complete. A copy of the review is enclosed for your records.

If the above specified conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**WARNING**

Keep away from humans, domestic animals and pets. May be fatal if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe vapor, or spray mist because this material will reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding. Exposure during pregnancy should be avoided.

Repeat as necessary, based on monitoring of prothrombin times.
