

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:
Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals**

DANGER: Fatal if inhaled. May be fatal if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe dust. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear a dust/mist filtering respirator (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C), eye goggles and rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash hands, arms and face before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Avoid exposure to this product during pregnancy. Repeated exposure to small amounts of this product can produce cumulative toxicity. Check prothrombin times of persons at risk periodically.

FIRST AID: Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have Person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with plenty of cool water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: If swallowed or absorbed through the skin, this material may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding. If ingested, administer Vitamin K₁, intramuscularly or orally. Repeat as necessary based on monitoring of prothrombin times. In severe cases, blood transfusions may be necessary.

TREATMENT FOR PET POISONING: If animal eat bait, call veterinarian at once.

NOTE TO VETERINARIAN: Anticoagulant Chlorophacinone: For animals ingesting bait and/or showing poisoning signs (bleeding or prolonged prothrombin times), give Vitamin K₁. In severe cases, blood transfusions may be needed.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer system without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.
