**Subject: Application for amendment and revised labeling for Maki Pellets Bait Packs (Bromadiolone)  
EPA Reg. No. 7173-221  
Your Submission Dated October 13, 2003**

The Agency has reviewed your application for amendment dated October 13, 2003 and your revised label submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act.

- Your request to change the name of your product from "Maki Rodenticide Bait Packs (Pellets) with Bitrex" to "Maki Pellets Bait Packs" is acceptable.
- Your request to allow the sale of packages containing 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 or 10 bait packs, individual bait packs bearing the full product label with "mouse only" directions for use, and "bulk" packages ranging in size from 1 pound up to 50 pounds is acceptable. Please note that all packages containing greater than 1 pound of product require additional precautionary statements labeling language noted in the Agency's comments below.
- The labeling referred to above, as amended, is acceptable provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

1. Under **Directions for Use**, after the violation of Federal law statement, add the following statement:
  - "Do not apply this product by any method not specified on this label."
2. Under **Directions for Use** in the "Use Restrictions" section:

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- In the second sentence, add “human or pet” before the last word “food.”
  - Add, “Do not place near or inside ventilation duct openings.”
  - Modify the urban areas use restriction as follows: “This product may be used indoors. May only be used outdoors within 15 feet of homes, industrial, commercial, and public buildings.” Change the phrase “in and around related port or terminal buildings” to “inside or within 15 feet of related port or terminal buildings.”
3. Under **Directions for Use**, in the Application Directions section:
- ***On the Rat and Mouse Label:***  
In the second sentence in both the “Rats:” and “Mice:” sections, at the end of the sentences starting with “Space placements...” add “no further than 15 feet from the structures.”
  - ***On the “Mouse only” Label:***  
In the second sentence under Application Directions, at the end of the sentence starting with “Space placements...” add “no further than 15 feet from the structures.”
4. Under **Directions for Use** in the Application Directions section:
- ***On the Rat and Mouse Label:***  
In the second sentence of the “Follow-up” section, insert “Wear gloves to” prior to “collect and properly dispose of all dead animals...”
  - ***On the “Mouse only” Label:***  
In the fifth sentence under Application Directions, insert “Wear gloves to” prior to “collect and properly dispose of all dead animals...”

## **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

5. Under **Precautionary Statements**, after the signal word and statement “Keep away from humans, domestic animals and pets”: replace the text starting with “May be harmful...” and ending with “...eating and smoking.” with the following:
- ***For products less than or equal to one pound:***  
“Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin because the material may reduce the clotting ability of blood and cause bleeding. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. If bait is handled, wear waterproof gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Users should

remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.”

- ***For products greater than one pound:***

“Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin because the material may reduce the clotting ability of blood and cause bleeding. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wear shirt and long pants, shoes and socks and chemical-resistant (such as waterproof) gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Users should remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.” (See No. 6 below for additional text required for products greater than one pound.)

6. Under **Precautionary Statements**, *for products greater than one pound*, add a “User Safety Requirements” heading and section following the “Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals” section with the following text: “Follow manufacturer’s instructions for cleaning/maintaining Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.”
7. Under **Precautionary Statements**, in the “First Aid” section, after the current “If Swallowed” statement, add the following: “Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow” and “Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.” Or since the product is toxicity category IV by the oral route of exposure, you may delete the “If Swallowed” statement completely.
8. Under **Precautionary Statements**, in the “First Aid” section, it is recommended that separate “Note to Physician” and “Note to Veterinarian” text be placed on the labels.

- The “**Note to Physician**” section should read:

“This product may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause hemorrhaging. If poisoning symptoms occur, intramuscular and oral administration of Vitamin K1 may be needed. For human cases, Vitamin K1 is antidotal at 5-10 mg (not mg/kg) for children and 10-20 mg for adults. Repeated doses may be needed (based on monitoring of prothrombin times).”

- The “**Note to Veterinarian**” section must be revised as specified below and placed within a box:

“TREATMENT FOR PET POISONINGS

If pet or animal eats bait, call a veterinarian or Hotline Number (1-800-301-

7976) at once.

**NOTE TO VETERINARIAN**

This product contains bromadiolone, an anticoagulant. For animals ingesting (or suspected of ingesting) bait, and/or having obvious poisoning symptoms, such as bleeding or lowered prothrombin times, give Vitamin K1 at 2-5 mg/kg. Repeated doses may be needed for up to 30 days (based on monitoring of prothrombin times). It may be necessary to check prothrombin times every 3 days until values return to normal. In severe cases, blood transfusions may be necessary.

9. Under **Precautionary Statements**, in the "Environmental Hazards" section:

- In the second sentence, insert "Dogs and other" prior to "predatory and scavenging..."

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

10. In the **Storage and Disposal** box for both non-household and household use:


- Under the "Storage" section, add the word "cool" before "dry location" (for non-household statement) and "dry place" (for household statement).

**GENERAL**

11. The Agency recommends the registrant include a company telephone number or toll-free hotline number along with its name and address.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE (continued from right column)

**Rats:** Apply 3 to 10 packs per bait placement. Space placements at 15 to 30 foot intervals in infested areas. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of bait for at least 10 days or until there are no new signs of rat activity.

(Qualifier statement for 8 x 1.5 oz package only.) The bait packs in this package contain enough bait (12 oz.) to kill three to twelve rats.

(Qualifier statement for 10 x 1.5 oz package only.) The bait packs in this package contain enough bait (15 oz.) to kill four to fourteen rats.
