If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: If swallowed or absorbed through the skin, this material may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding. If ingested, administer Vitamin K_1 intramuscularly or orally. Repeat as necessary based on monitoring of prothrombin times. In severe cases, blood transfusions may be necessary.

TREATMENT FOR PET POISONING: If animal eats bait, call veterinarian at once. **NOTE TO VETERINARIAN: Anticoagulant Difethialone:** For animals ingesting bait and/or showing poison signs, (bleeding or prolonged prothrombin times), give Vitamin K_1 . If needed, check prothrombin times every 3 days until values return to normal, (up to 30 days.) In severe cases, blood transfusions may be necessary.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Fatal if inhaled. May be fatal if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Do not breathe dust. Wear a dust/mist filtering respirator (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C), eye goggles and rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash hands, arms and face before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Avoid exposure to this product during pregnancy. Repeated exposure to small amounts of this product can produce cumulative toxicity. Check prothrombin times of persons at risk periodically.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is extremely toxic to fish and wildlife. Dogs and predatory and scavenging mammals and birds might be poisoned if they feed upon animals that have eaten this bait. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge.
