

Fowllow-up: Replace contaminated or spould bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all visible dead animals and leftover belt properly. To discourage reintestation, limit sources of rodent food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation occurs, repeat treatment. For a continuous infestation, set up permanent bait stations and replenish bait as needed.
