DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ THIS LABEL and follow all use directions and precautions.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets or other nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals, and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hoofed livestock, raccoons, bears, other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product container, unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

USE RESTRICTIONS: This product may be used to control Norway rats, roof rats and house mice. Do not place bait where it may contaminate food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food.

URBAN AREAS: This product may only be used in and around homes, industrial, commercial and public buildings. This product may be used in transport vehicles (ships, trains, aircraft) and in and around related port or terminal buildings. Applications "around" buildings must be in tamper-resistant bait stations placed along the walls or other external parts of buildings (doorways, ramps, loading docks) where rats or mice might seek to gain entrance.

NON-URBAN AREAS: Use inside homes and agricultural buildings.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where rats or mice are likely to find and consume bait, such as along walls, by gnawed openings, corners and concealed places, between floors or walls, or locations where rodents or their signs are seen. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

House Mice: Apply 1/4 to 1/2 ounce of bait per placement. Larger amount (up to 2 ounces) may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Space placements 8 to 12 feet apart. Maintain a constant supply of fresh bait for 15 days or until signs of mouse activity cease.

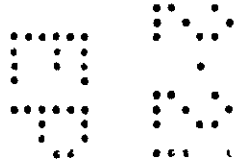
Rats: Apply 3 to 16 ounces of bait per placement. Space bait placements 15 to 30 feet apart. Maintain a constant supply of fresh bait for 10 days or until signs of rat activity cease.

For burrow applications, insert 1/2 to 1 ounce of bait deep into each active burrow. Check treated burrows each morning and evening to make sure that bait has not been pushed out of burrows.

Follow-up: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all visible dead animals and leftover bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation occurs, repeat treatment. For a continuous infestation, set up permanent bait stations and replenish bait as needed.
