Purpose The purpose of this submission is to revise the label of this product, under section 3 of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA).

Label The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following change, before you ship your product.

1. Revise the 1st Sentence of your "USE RESTRICTIONS", wherever it occurs, to read, "This product may **only** be used to control"
2. Revise the 2nd Sentence under "CAUTION", wherever it occurs, to read: "May be harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin because it may reduce the clotting ability of blood and cause bleeding."
3. On the full place pack label, add this 2nd Sentence after "READ THIS LABEL": "It is illegal to sell these placepacks individually."


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- 4. Delete the optional marketing claim, "Newest second-generation, single-feed anticoagulant rodenticide."

Note: In the future, include an Amended Application Form (EPA Form 8570-1) when amending the labeling of a product.
