**Your submissions of March 8, July 12, August 12, and September 1, 2005**

**Purpose**      These submissions, under section 3 of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), include A) storage and stability data required as a condition of registration; B) a revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated August 12, 2005, which deleted several inert ingredients from your formula; and revised labeling.

**Chemistry Data**      We have reviewed the storage and stability data (MRID No. 464944-01) required as a condition of registration and found them acceptable.

**CSF**      Your CSF of August 12, 2005, deleting four inert ingredients in your formula, is acceptable. We have placed a copy of this CSF in our files for this product. All other versions are obsolete.

**Labeling**      The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following changes, before you ship your product.

1. Under "USE DIRECTIONS"; delete the following sentence that greatly expands the use of this product:

This product is especially well suited for use in wet or damp areas, including river banks, gullies, irrigation ditches, railroad tracks, loading areas, under granaries, along fence lines and buffer strips, garbage dumps and landfills.

2. Replace the above text with that approved on the last accepted label of February 14, 2005:

Applications "around" buildings must be in tamper-resistant bait stations placed along the walls or other external parts of buildings (doorways, ramps, loading docks) where rats or mice might seek to gain entrance.

**Existing stocks**

Stocks of products with existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.

**Consequence for non-compliance**

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**  
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**READ THIS LABEL** and follow all use directions and precautions.  
**IMPORTANT:** Do not expose children, pets or other nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help prevent accidents:  
1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.  
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals, and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hoofed livestock, raccoons, bears, other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.  
3. Dispose of product container, unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

**USE RESTRICTIONS:** This product may be used to control Norway rats, roof rats and house mice in and around homes, industrial, commercial, agricultural and public buildings. It may also be used in transport vehicles (ships, trains, aircraft) and in and around related port or terminal buildings. This product is especially well suited for use in areas such as river banks, gullies, irrigation ditches, railroad tracks, loading areas, under granaries, along fence lines and buffer strips, garbage dumps and landfills.  
Do not place bait where it may contaminate food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Do not apply bait directly to ground surface or in grass or other ground cover. Where necessary, apply in tamper-resistant bait stations to prevent non-target animals from accessing the bait. Do not broadcast bait.  
**Selection of Treatment Areas:** Determine areas where rats or mice are likely to find and consume bait, such as along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors or walls, or locations where rodents or their signs are seen. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

This package contains enough bait (4 oz.) to kill 1 to 3 rats.  
*(Qualifier statement only for package containing 6 blocks:)*  
This package contains enough bait (6 oz.) to kill 2 to 5 rats.  
*(Qualifier statement only for package containing 8 blocks:)*  
This package contains enough bait (8 oz.) to kill 3 to 8 rats.  
*(Qualifier statement only for package containing 10 blocks:)*  
This package contains enough bait (10 oz.) to kill 4 to 10 rats.

**Mice:** Apply one block per placement. Two blocks may be needed at points of extremely high mouse activity. Space placements at 8 to 12 feet apart. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 15 days or until signs of mouse activity cease.  
**Rats:** Apply 4 to 16 blocks per placement, usually spaced 15 to 30 feet apart. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for 10 days or until signs of rat activity cease.  
**Follow-up:** Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all visible dead animals and leftover bait properly. To discourage reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. For a continuous infestation, set up permanent bait stations and replenish bait as needed. (2005)
