Purpose This submission proposes to revise the label for this product, under sec 3 of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), to clarify the product name, add "mouse only" labels, to add a "Do not tear ..." claim, to revise the presentation of the "single feeding" claim, and to add a "newest second-generation" claim for this product.

Review We have reviewed your these requests for labeling changes and have the following comments:

1. Your request to change the product name of record to "Generation Meal Bait Packs" is acceptable.
2. Your new "mouse only" label is acceptable.
3. Your proposed label includes the addition of a new optional marketing claim to your label, "Do not tear open the pack. Rats and mice will chew through the wrapper to get at the bait." This request is acceptable, provided that they appear as two complete sentences, with proper punctuation, as shown above.

Review-continued

- 4. Your proposed label includes the addition of a new optional marketing claim to your label, "**Newest second-generation, single-feed anticoagulant rodenticide**". This statement is unacceptable. While the statement is true, it is misleading since the active ingredient is no longer "new", having been on the market since 1995, eleven (11) years ago.
- 5. Your proposed label includes a third new optional marketing claim to your label, "**Can kill in one feeding***". You said that several competitors were putting this statement on the label of their products and putting the full text ("***Norway rats and house mice can consume a lethal dose in one night's feeding with first dead rodents appearing four or five days after feeding begins.**") on another portion of the label.

We have consistently found this statement misleading over the past 20 years or more and have disapproved its use.

If you have noticed this practice in the market, please document it. If we have approved its use, we will contact the company and require that they phase out its use. If we did not approve it, we will forward that information to enforcement. As you are aware, the basic registrant is responsible for the labels of distributor products. Further, if a registrant submitted such a claim via the Notification process, the product could also be subject to enforcement action and penalties.

Labeling

The labeling submitted with the above letter is acceptable, provided that you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, with the following change, before you ship the product.

- 1. Your first optional marketing claim needs to appear as "Do not tear open the pack. Rats and mice will chew through the wrapper to get at the bait."
- 2. Delete the second optional marketing claim, "**Can kill in one feeding***".
- 3. Delete the optional marketing claim, "**Newest second-generation, single-feed anticoagulant rodenticide**".

Existing stocks Forms

Stocks of product with existing labels may be used for eighteen (18) months.

Consequence for non-compliance

If this condition is not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for

shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

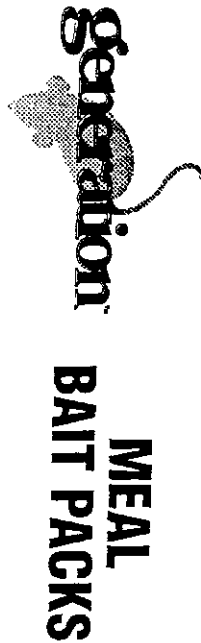

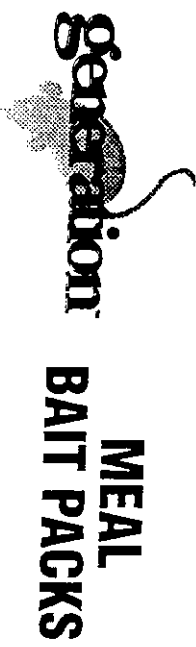

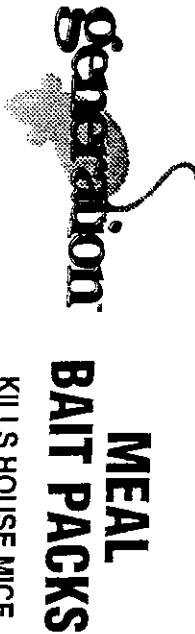
