 - 2. Revise the 2nd Sentence under "CAUTION", wherever it occurs, to read: "May be harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin because it may reduce the clothing ability of blood and cause bleeding."
 - 3. On the full place pack label, add this 2nd Sentence after "**READ THIS LABEL**": "It is illegal to sell these placepacks individually."

4. Delete the optional marketing claim, "Newest second-generation, single-feed anticoagulant rodenticide."
