5. Until a claim for use of this product in sewers is accepted, delete the "**For sewer applications ... manhole**" paragraph from the "**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:**" pertaining to "**Rats:**".

When acceptable rat and mouse efficacy data on weathered bait are submitted, the second sentence of the "**Urban Areas:**" paragraph below may be changed to "This product also may be used in sewers". DIRECTIONS FOR USE
