3. At your option, you may delete "Total 100.00000%".
4. Move "**KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN**" to the left and closer to the signal word, "**CAUTION**".
5. Since you only sell these bait stations singularly, modify your "**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS**" as follows, beginning with the 2nd Sentence, "Place bait station along wall or in corner at point of highest activity where mice or their signs have been seen. If additional units are purchased, space bait stations 8 to 12 feet apart. Placements ... "
6. On the "Bait Station" label, align the text, "Active Ingredient" to the same left margin as the text, "Inert Ingredients".
7. At your option, you may delete "Total 100.00000%".
8. Add the registration number to your label, "EPA Reg. No. 7173-253".
9. Begin your "**WARRANTY**" text, with "To the extent consistent with applicable law, seller ...".
10. In the optional marketing claims, delete "NO TOUCH".
11. Remove the two asterisks in the single feeding claim. If you want to include the text, "CAN KILL IN ONE FEEDING", then the rest of the text must be identical in every respect and must appear together on the label. At re-registration, we will re-evaluate the wording again and require everyone to use the same language.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Use only to control house mice in homes, industrial, commercial, agricultural and public buildings. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where mice will most likely find and consume bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, in corners and concealed places.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS: Remove bait station from package and place bait station in horizontal position with side against the wall, exposing both entrances. Space bait stations 8 to 12 feet apart along walls or in corners where mice or their signs have been seen. Replace bait stations if contents are consumed or contaminated. Placements not touched after 3 days should be moved to new locations where mouse activity is evident. Continuous bait supply is important for complete rodent eradication. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait properly. To discourage reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation occurs, repeat treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: This is a nonrefillable container. Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Disposal: If empty: Do not reuse or refill this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
