Check prothrombin time every 3 days until values return to normal.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Predatory and scavenging mammals and birds might be poisoned if they feed upon animals that have eaten the bait. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **READ THIS LABEL** and follow all use directions and use precautions.

USE RESTRICTIONS: This is not a tamper-resistant bait station. Do not use this product in areas accessible to children, pets, domestic animals or nontarget wildlife. Do not use this product outdoors. Use only to control house mice in homes, industrial, commercial, agricultural and public buildings. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food.

Selection of Treatment Areas: Determine areas where mice will most likely find and consume bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, in corners and concealed places, between floors or walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS: Remove bait station from package and place in horizontal positions with side against wall, exposing entrance. Space stations 8 to 12 feet apart along walls or in corners where mice or their signs have been seen. Replace bait stations if contents are consumed or contaminated. Placements not touched after three days should be moved to new locations where mouse activity is evident. Continuous bait supply is important for complete rodent eradication. Wearing gloves, collect and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait properly. To discourage reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation occurs, repeat treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: This is a nonrefillable container. Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Disposal: If empty: Do not reuse or refill this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
