

USE RESTRICTIONS: This is not a tamper-resistant bait station. Do not use this product in areas accessible to children, pets, domestic animals or nontarget wildlife. Do not use this product outdoors. Use only to control house mice in homes, industrial, commercial, agricultural and public buildings. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Selection of Treatment Areas: Determine areas where mice will most likely find and consume bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, in corners and concealed places, between floors or walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS: Remove bait station from package and place in horizontal positions with side against wall, exposing entrance. Space stations 8 to 12 feet apart along walls or in corners where mice or their signs have been seen. Replace bait stations if contents are consumed or contaminated. Placements not touched after three days should be moved to new locations where mouse activity is evident. Continuous bait supply is important for complete rodent eradication. Wearing gloves, collect and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait properly. To discourage reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation occurs, repeat treatment


