Purpose

The purpose of your submission of March 12, 2008, is to revise the labeling for this product to remove any labeling on individually wrapped blocks, under section 3 of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA).

Notification

Your Notification of September 1, 2008, was unacceptable because you have added marketing claims to your label. Therefore, we are reviewing this submission as a label amendment. Labeling comments refer to both submissions referred to above.

#### Label **General Comment:**

Now that the Agency has issued its May 28, 2008, "Risk Mitigation Decision for 10 Rodenticides", it will begin to re-register products subject to 1998 Rodenticide Cluster RED, and to require that companies revise the product labeling to be consistent with the RED, as amended during the past 10 years. We will also require rodenticides not subject to the RED to make similar label changes, if applicable, so that all rodenticides are consistent with current requirements and are "on a level playing field". However, any changes in labeling or "terms and conditions" only required by the Risk Mitigation Decision will be required in the schedule outlined in that document.

#### Labelcontinued

The labeling submitted with the above letter, under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) will be acceptable, provided you submit three (3) copies of revised labeling, with the following changes, for our review:

1) Revise your "CAUTION" text under "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" text, wherever it occurs, as follows:

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin because it may reduce the clotting ability of blood and cause bleeding. Keep away from children, domestic animals and pets. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. All handlers (including applicators) must wear shoes plus socks, and gloves. [Delete previous sentence for sizes 1 lb or less.] Any person who retrieves carcasses or unused bait following application of this product must wear gloves.

#### **User Safety Requirements**

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry. Remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash hands thoroughly after applying bait and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet and change into clean clothing.

Delete "User Safety Requirements" for sizes 1 lb or less.]

#### Labelcontinued

2) Revise your "FIRST AID" and "Note To Physician or Veterinarian" text as follows:

## FIRST AID HAVE LABEL WHEN OBTAINING TREATMENT ADVICE IF SWALLOWED:

- Call a poison control center, doctor, or 1-800-858-7378<sup>1</sup> [optional] immediately for treatment advice.
- Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.

#### IF ON SKIN:

- Take off contaminated clothing.
- Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
- Call a poison control center, doctor, or 1-800-858-7378 for treatment advice.

Also call this number for information on health concerns and pesticide incidents.

#### TREATMENT FOR PET POISONING

If animal eats bait, call veterinarian or 1-800-xxx-xxxx [optional] at once.

#### NOTE TO PHYSICIAN OR VETERINARIAN

Anticoagulant Difethialone: If swallowed, this material may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding. For humans or dogs that have ingested this product and/or have obvious poisoning symptoms (bleeding or prolonged prothrombin times), give Vitamin  $K_1$  intramuscularly or orally. For dogs, check prothrombin times every 3 days until values return to normal (up to 30 days). In severe cases, blood transfusions may be needed.

#### Labelcontinued

3) Revise the second sentence of the "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" section to read as follows:

Dogs and predatory and scavenging mammals and birds might be poisoned if they feed upon animals that have eaten this bait.

- 4) Follow Enclosure 1 to revise your "Storage and Disposal" texts, which must include text for sizes a) greater than 1 lb (plastic and paper) and 2) 1 lb or less.
- 5) After "**READ THIS LABEL**", wherever it occurs, add this 2<sup>nd</sup> Sentence, "Use only for the sites, pests, and application methods described on this label."
- 6) In the **USE RESTRICTIONS** section, replace Sentence 2 and 3 with:

Do not use in edible product areas of food or feed processing plants or other areas where food or feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not contaminate food/feed or food/feed handling equipment or place near or inside ventilation duct openings.

- 7) In all versions of your labeling with rat directions, include standard directions for use for rats "in and around buildings".
- 8) Delete the "sewer use", wherever it occurs, as you have not shown this formula to be "weather-resistant" and the claim is not currently on the product that is identical to this one in shape and formula. Finally, given the small size of the block, it is unlikely that such a product would be appropriate for sewers.
- 9) On the Retail Consumer Label Option 2, revise the "Application Directions" according to Enclosure 2.
- 10)On the Retail Consumer Label Options 1 and 2, follow Enclosure 1 for "Storage and Disposal" text.
- 11) Your "Alternate Storage and Disposal Statement" for "Household Use" is unacceptable. Follow Enclosure 1. It must have a "Storage and Disposal" heading.

#### Labelcontinued

12) Under your alternate Warranty text, delete "safety and" so that it reads as follows: "To the extent consistent with applicable law, buyer assumes all responsibility for use not in accordance with directions."

- 13)Delete "Place Pack" from the heading for the "Wrapped Mini Blocks". This is not a place pack product.
- 14)On the Front Panel of the Wrapper label, include the
  - a. product name,
  - b. "CAUTION: Keep Out of Reach of Children. See carton for complete directions and precautions.
  - c. "It is illegal to sell these wrapped blocks individually."
  - d. "Active Ingredient: Difethialone ... 0.0025%".
  - e. "EPA Reg. No. 7173-284"

The rest of the text can go on the Back Panel: net weight, registration number, company name, address, telephone number, and marketing claims (if there is room). All text must be at least 6 pt type.

- 15) We have not evaluated the validity of marketing statement, "Kill up to X mice (1 mouse for every 3 g of product in package)". When we do an evaluation, we will inform you of any labeling changes needed.
- 16) Delete the following marketing claims:
  - i. "Can kill in 1 feeding" [Can only use the approved "Front Panel" text.
  - ii. "Kill with Ortho Power" [This is a misleading, meaningless claim.]
  - iii. "Powerful Ortho Killing Baits"
  - iv. "Simple set and kill"
  - v. "Easy placement around the home"
  - vi. "Kill Mice 100% dead" [Implies 100% control.]
  - vii. Kill mice and rats 100% dead" [Implies 100% control.]
  - viii. "Ortho's best." and "Ortho's best solution" [Such statements are misleading at best.]
  - ix. "Ready ... and die!" [Use directions do not belong with the marketing claims.]
  - x. "Use inside ...appliances" unless you add the following text: "in areas inaccessible to children, pets, and nontarget wildlife or in tamper-resistant bait stations".

#### **Enclosure 1. Storage and Disposal Texts**

#### [Containers Over 1 Pound]

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store only in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Keep containers closed and away from other chemicals.
