Maintain a constant supply of fresh bait for 15 days or until signs of house House Mice: Apply 1 pouch per placement, usually spaced 8 to 12 feet apart. Up to 4 pouches may be needed at points of very high house mouse activity,

Follow-up: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately.
