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USE INSTRUCTIONS

HOMEOUSEHOLD: For sanitizing and disinfecting previously cleaned floors, walls, and unpolished hard surfaces. For Schools, Nurseries, Canteens, Restrooms, Garbage Pail, Sink Tops, Corridors, Classrooms, Offices and Shower Stalls. Apply solution with mop or cloth. Sanitize with 1 ounce of Clockwork to 4 gallons of water. Disinfect with 3 ounces of Clockwork to 5 gallons of water. Rinse thoroughly with water and ammonia. Chlorine bleach at 3 ounces of Clockwork to 4 gallons of water.

HOSPITAL: DISINFECTANT for floors, walls and other hard surfaces. In Nursing Homes, Institutions, as well as Schools, Garbage Pails, Restrooms and Restrooms. Use Clockwork at 3% ounces per 5 gallons of water. At this level Clockwork will be effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* PRD 10.

FOOD PROCESSING PLANT: For Sanitization of previously cleaned food processing equipment and food utensils. Dilute 1 ounce of Clockwork per 4 gallons of water to provide 200 ppm of active quaternary. Apply with cloth or brush or immerse articles completely in sanitizing solution. At this level, no potable water rinse is required.

DAIRY: Sanitize previously cleaned dairy equipment such as tanks, pans, sinks, and floors. Apply sanitizing solution containing 1 ounce of Clockwork to 4 gallons of water (200 ppm). At this level, no potable water rinse is required. Follow recommendations of local health board.

DISINFECTANT: For disinfection of previously cleaned surgical instruments, barber tools and dental equipment. Immerse, submerge instrument in solution containing 1% ounces of Clockwork per gallon of water for 10 minutes.

RESTAURANT AND BAR RINSE: Dishes, glassware, silverware, cooking utensils, wash with a good synthetic detergent, rinse thoroughly and immerse in a sanitizing solution containing 1 ounce of Clockwork to 4 gallons of water. No potable water rinse is required.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT Hazard to Human and Domestic Animals

DANGER

Irritant to skin and eyes. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear gloves or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. If in case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eye contact, flush with water and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk or egg whites. If in solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE: In case of ingestion, Probable mucous damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

PROHIBITIONS: DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL. OPEN DUMPING IS PROHIBITED. DO NOT REUSE EMPTY CONTAINER.
PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: PESTICIDE SPRAY MIXTURE OR RESIDUE THAT CANNOT BE USED OR CHEMICALLY REPRODUCED SHOULD BE DISPOSED OF IN A LANDFILL APPROVED FOR PESTICIDES OR BURIED IN A SAFE PLACE AWAY FROM WATER SUPPLIES.
