Directions For Use

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Clockwork provides sanitizing, disinfecting and deodorizing in Hospitals, Food Processing Plants, Dairies, Restaurants, Bars, and other institutions. When used as recommended, it is effective as a sanitizer against Escherichia Coli and Staphylococcus aureus; and as a disinfectant against Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis and Pseudomonas aeruginosa. Clockwork is authorized under the Food Additive Ammendment of the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act for use as a sanitizing solution at 200 ppm active level without requiring a final potable water ringe.

Authorized by USDA for use in federally inspected meat and poultry plants.

SANITIZATION- To sanitize previously cleaned and rinsed non-porous food contact surfaces, prepare 200 ppm active quaternary solution by adding 1 ounce Clockwork to 4 gallons of water.

When used for sanitization of previously cleaned food equipment or food contact items, limit active quaternaries to 200 ppm. At this level NO POTABLE WATER RINSE is required.

DISINFECTION- At 3 ounces per 5 gallon dilution. Clockwork exhibits effective disinfectant activity against the organisms Salmonella choleraesuis and Staphylococcus aureus.

At 3½ ounces per 5 gallons dilution, Clockwork is an acceptable hosp:tal disinfectant and demonstrates disinfectant activity against Pseudomonas aeruginosa.

(To disinfect previously cleaned hard inanimate surfaces (such as walls, floors, table tops), apply Clockwork with mop, cloth, or sponge or mychanical sprayer so as to wet thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and then let air dry.

For disinfection of previously cleaned surgical instruments, barber tools and dental equipment, simply submerge instruments into solution containing ly ounces of Clockwork per gallon of water for 10 minutes.

DEDDORIZER- To deodorize, apply Clockwork as indicated under the heading "General Disinfection" above.
