#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

##### General Classification

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in

**DISINFECTION** To clean and disinfect floors and other hard  
surfaces, mix Sundance-Q 1 oz. per gallon of water. Wet surface  
thoroughly with clean mop, sponge, or cloth. Allow to remain wet  
for 10 minutes, and to air dry.

On floors, Sundance-Q won't blush or dull the shine as it cleans  
and disinfects at the recommended dilution.

Sundance-Q is for hospitals, nursing homes, schools, food processing  
and service facilities, and other institutions.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**DISINFECTION AND CLEANING** To disinfect, clean and deodorize hard non porous surfaces such as bath room tiles, floors, shower stalls, walls, sinks and toilet tubs, proceed as indicated below:

1. Hold container six to eight inches from surface to be treated. 2. Spray area until it is covered with the solution. Allow the product to penetrate and remain wet for 10 minutes. No scrubbing necessary. 3. Wipe off with a clean cloth, mop or sponge. The product will not leave color or soap scum.

For heavily soiled areas, remove gross soil before treatment.

**MILDEWSTAT** To control mold and mildew on hard non porous surfaces (such as floors, walls, table tops) spray the surfaces to be treated making sure to get completely wet. Let air dry. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth reappears.
