DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Control of Sap Stain and Mold

DO NOT REUSE CONTAINER.

DESTROY WHEN EMPTY

LUMBER. Dissolve 5 lbs. LUMBERITE in 100 gallons of water. Dip or spray the fresh green lumber in this solution to thoroughly wet the boards. If necessary, add alkali to the solution to maintain a pH in excess of 7.5 at all times. Avoid excessively alkaline solutions since they may cause discoloration of beech and other hardwoods.

LOGS. Spray ends and debarked areas of fresh logs with a solution of 10 lbs. LUMBERITE in 100 gallons water.

POLES, TIES, AND TIMBERS. Dip or spray entire surface with a solution of 10 lbs. LUMBERITE in 100 gallons water. Spray again when seasoning check develops. Maintain pH in excess of 7.5 at all times.

Properly stack all lumber dipped in LUMBERITE solution in piles with good foundations to allow adequate ventilation. Roof all piles to protect lumber from rain. Control of vegetation around stacks is recommended to afford better air circulation.
