Agitate contents of this container before diluting To prepare a ready-to-use solution of a water repellent wood preservative mix one (1) gallon of PENWAR CONCENTRATE (1-5 with five (5) gallons of Mineral Spirits, Fed. Spec. TT. T-291 -Thinner, Paint, Volatile Mineral Spirits Solutions, mixed as recommended above, will comply with Fed. Spec. TT-W-572 for Wood Preservative. Water Repellent Composition A

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Best results would be obtained by using wood pressure-treated with our product PENWAR In lieu of that next best results will be obtained by immersing wood to be treated in PENWAR for 3 minutes minimum plus three minutes for each inch of thickness. Where dipping is not possible two or more liberal brush or spray applications should be made. Rewet wood surface with Penwar immediately after application to give high retentions and better penetration. Allow at least 24 hours and preferably longer before application of varnish or paint. Brush, spray or dip to obtain maximum absorption on cut surfaces
