

FOR ADZED SURFACES OF TIES IN TRACK, POLE & PILING CUT OFF, CUT SURFACES OF SAWN TIMBERS OR WHERE MORE PRESERVATIVE IS NEEDED TO PROTECT THE WOOD PRODUCT IN USE

For treatment of wood in place. Spray, brush or swab with **PENTACON-7** to the point of run off.

WOOD PRESERVATION

Where maximum protection of wood out of salt water location is desired use wood pressure treated with Pentachlorophenol solutions. When lesser protection will suffice or Pentachlorophenol pressure treated wood is not available apply **PENTACON-7** to wood by the following methods: Hot and Cold Bath Process (Thermal Process), Cold Soaking, Dipping, Brushing and Spraying. Results obtained will be dependent on depth of penetration and retention of preservative. Where severe exposure conditions prevail use hot and cold bath or cold soaking. Fence posts should be debarked and dried, and cold soaked for 24 to 72 hours, depending on whether the treatment is made in the summer or winter. Deal lumber for severe exposure conditions by soaking at least three hours per inch of thickness. Dipping, brushing and spraying may be used for less severe exposure conditions. For more **PENTACON-7** specified the better the treatment. Wind breakers preservative treated as recommended above will be protected against fungus growths which cause rot and stain, against termites and powder post (Lyctus) beetles. Brush, Spray and Swabbing treatments may be used on lumber in place and excavation for less severe conditions of exposure. For protection against powder post beetles, by fast fungal growths which cause rot and stain. For wood in contact with the soil a complete immersion for 3 minutes or 2 heavy applications with brush or spray is a minimum requirement. One gallon treats approximately 100 sq ft by brushing, spraying or swabbing.

For protection against termites, treat wood prior to use in construction.

Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves when handling the freshly treated lumber.

GROUND LINE TREATMENT OF POLES

After excavating and inspecting pole pour **PENTACON-7** around pole around and fill pole in back filled. Use from 1-1/2 to 5 gallons depending on the size of the pole and, upon the specification existent.

CHEMICAL MOW

FOR WEED AND GRASS CONTROL IN NON-CROP AREA. Use **PENTACON-7** as is or mix 1 part to 7 parts of a light petroleum solvent such as kerosene, mineral spirits, diesel fuel or light furnace oil, and apply for a chemical mow at the rate of 150 to 300 gallons per acre, dependent on the height and density of vegetation. Kill annual weeds. Perennials will be burned to the ground, but will regrow in several weeks or months. For use in Lumber yards, Industrial Plant yards, Railroad track and Right-of-way, Fence rows and similar non-crop areas. Do not apply to areas underlaid by roots of desirable trees and shrubs. Avoid spray drift to desirable plants. Do not contaminate water used for irrigation or domestic purposes.
