DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply without dilution as a strip treatment to cracks, crevices and other roach harborages and to ant runways. Use coarse wet spray and apply until the surface is wet to the point of run-off (approximately 1 gallon per 1000 square feet)

Re-apply only when reinfestation is noted. Do not use for space spray or for residual treatment covering extensive indoor surfaces as entire bulkheads and overheads
