LEFT SIDE LABEL:

Sanitizing showers, stalls, bathtubs, floors, toilet seats:

Clean surface with HASTE at "B" level. Rinse thoroughly and then sanitize with a solution of 1 teaspoon Germicidal per gallon of water, either wiped or sprayed on. Allow to dry on the surface. The residual germicide on the surface gives effective inhibition activity after treatment when used in this manner.

Sanitizing diapers:

After laundering, rinse diapers in a one teaspoon Germicidal to one gallon of water solution and allow diapers to dry without rinsing, so a residual is left in the diapers. This prevents urine decomposition by micro-organisms, which cause irritation commonly identified as diaper rash.

Sanitizing and deodorizing refrigerators, cupboards, storage bins, bread boxes, etc.:

Wipe or spray on a solution of 1 teaspoon Germicidal per gallon of water after cleaning with Haste at "B" level, and rinsing with clean water. Do not allow Germicide to come in concact with focd.

Sickroom:

Sanitize all utensils used in sick room by allowing to stand for at least two minutes in a solution of one teaspoon Germicidal per galion of water. Bedding and
