For deodorizing garbage cans, garbage trucks, industrial waste receptacles, and garbage handling equipment. It is especially important to pre-clean for the product to perform properly. Then apply a wetting concentration of 8 oz. of THIS PRODUCT per gallon of water.

For mildew control: Follow directions for hospital disinfection. Repeat treatment every seven days or when new growth appears.
