When used as directed, this product is an effective disinfectant, deodorant, and sanitizer. When used as a sanitizer, food contact surfaces, equipment, and utensils can be air dried after immersion in a 1 oz./4 gallon solution without a potable water rinse.

When used as directed, this product mixes with water to form clear, stable use solutions that are non-corrosive and non-staining to most common metals, plastics, and tile.

Types of surfaces suitable for disinfection include glass, smooth metal, washable painted wood or metal, vinyl, glazed porcelain, plastic, finished leather, finished wood and similar non-porous, hard, smooth surfaces.

Always preclean surfaces with a suitable detergent and rinse well with water before disinfection. After cleaning, apply a solution containing 1 ounce of Disinfectant per gallon of water for usual disinfecting applications. For disinfecting contagious disease areas, use 1 1/2 ounces per gallon of water.
