DIRECTIONS

Fogging operations outdoors should be confined to periods of little or no wind—in general, after sunset. Area to be fogged should always be downwind from fogging unit. Since adult mosquitoes congregate in shrubbery and other vegetation, be sure these areas are thoroughly fogged. Care should be taken, however, not to overexpose plant life, since any oil-base insecticide, when improperly used, may injure vegetation. Do not use on food or feed crops. During peak mosquito breeding season, apply Home & Patio Fogging Spray at frequent intervals. Repeat as necessary. General outdoor fogging should be carried out only under surface inversion conditions which usually exist only from one hour after sunset, through the night, and until sunrise. During this time, providing the wind velocity is under 3-4 miles per hour, the fog will remain in the area and close to the ground the required time to be fully effective.

To control flies, mosquitoes and gnats, use 1½ gallons Home & Patio Fogging Spray per acre. Apply dense fog when wind is calm 1 to 5 seconds per 1,000 sq. ft.
