But for shallow rooted plants, the best application is just before the growing season is likely to have rainfall. It may be applied to any lawn or other grassed area. It is effective against weeds that are obtained when applied to bare soil or mowed vegetation.

**GENERAL WEED CONTROL** This herbicide is for use on non-crop areas for an extended period, from 1 to non-crop areas such as RAILROAD YARDS, TRUST EAREAS, HIGHWAY, PETROLEUM TANK FARMS, LUMBER YARDS, STORAGE AREAS and INDUSTRIAL PLANT SITES. Apply at 1.0 to 2.0 lb. a.i. per 100 sq. ft. Under adverse conditions or when hard-to-kill weeds are present, a higher rate may be used. For more complete information desired the maximum rate should be used.
