

DIRECTIONS

Terratox Industrial Weed Killer when used at high rates (200 lbs. to 800 lbs. per acre) is an effective contact herbicide for control of a wide range of annual and perennial grasses and herbaceous weeds. It is recommended specifically for use on NON CROPLAND areas such as:

RAILROAD TRACTS, YARDS, SIDINGS, SPURS
OIL REFINERIES, TANK FARMS, PIPE LINES
LUMBER YARDS, POLE YARDS
GRAIN ELEVATORS, GINS
POWER COMPANIES, SUB-STATIONS
EQUIPMENT STORAGE YARDS
PARKING LOTS
INDUSTRIAL PLANT SITES

TERRATOX Industrial Weed Killer is a dry powder designed primarily for application to ground areas by mechanical or hand dusters. The application of 200 pounds or more of the weed killer per acre usually renders the soil non-productive for extended periods. The rapidity and duration of effect will vary with the amount applied, the soil type, rainfall and other local conditions.

For non-crop use, the application of 200-400 pounds per acre will provide practical weed control for a period of 6 months or longer. Under adverse conditions or when hard-to-kill weeds such as established Johnson grass are present, or where longer term control is desired, apply larger quantities up to 800 pounds per acre. TERRATOX Industrial Weed Killer may be used at any time of year for general weed control, but for most satisfactory results should be applied just prior to or during seasons likely to have rainfall. It may be applied to dense weed growth, provided sufficient water is used but best results are obtained when applied to bare soil or mowed vegetation.

SPOT APPLICATIONS: For treatment of small areas where it is desired to kill all vegetation, apply 1 to 2 lbs. to cover a 100 square foot area. Although intended primarily for application as a dry powder, TERRATOX Industrial Weed Killer may be mixed with water at the rate of 1 lb. per gallon and applied as a water suspension, making sure to keep the mixture well agitated.

TERRATOX Industrial Weed Killer as such is non-fire hazardous. Ground surfaces and vegetation that have been thoroughly dusted or sprayed with this material will not burn or support combustion as readily as untreated.

Use TERRATOX Industrial Weed Killer only where it is specifically recommended. DO NOT apply on or near valuable woody or herbaceous plants or on areas into which their roots may extend. DO NOT use on lawns, walks, driveways, tennis courts. DO NOT apply to locations from which the TERRATOX Industrial Weed Killer may be washed onto areas where the roots of trees or other desirable plants may come in contact with the herbicide. Apply with extreme care to prevent drift of the spray or dry powder onto valuable plants or cropland. Keep from contact with fertilizers, insecticides, fungicides and seeds. Do not use sprayers with which TERRATOX Industrial Weed Killer has been applied for spraying insecticides, fungicides and fertilizers. Thoroughly clean application equipment after use to prevent possible contamination of herbicides subsequently used selectively in cropland. DO NOT reuse container. Destroy by burying with waste or burning. Stay away from smoke or fumes.
