### FOR HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES AND GNATS:

Close windows and doors. Remove or cover houseplants. Spray freely toward ceiling in all directions until room is filled with fine mist, then leave the room. Keep doors closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

**NOTE:** The solvent used in this formulation is a petroleum distillate which may stain certain materials. Care should be taken to avoid spotting of wallpaper and fabrics. Do not use a coarse spray for houseflies, mosquitoes and gnats. Keep sprayer nozzle at least 4 feet from wallpaper and fabrics.
