Prior to marketing, make the following label revisions:

a. The accepted chemical name for lindane should be utilized, i.e., Lindane (gamma isomer of benzene hexachloride).

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

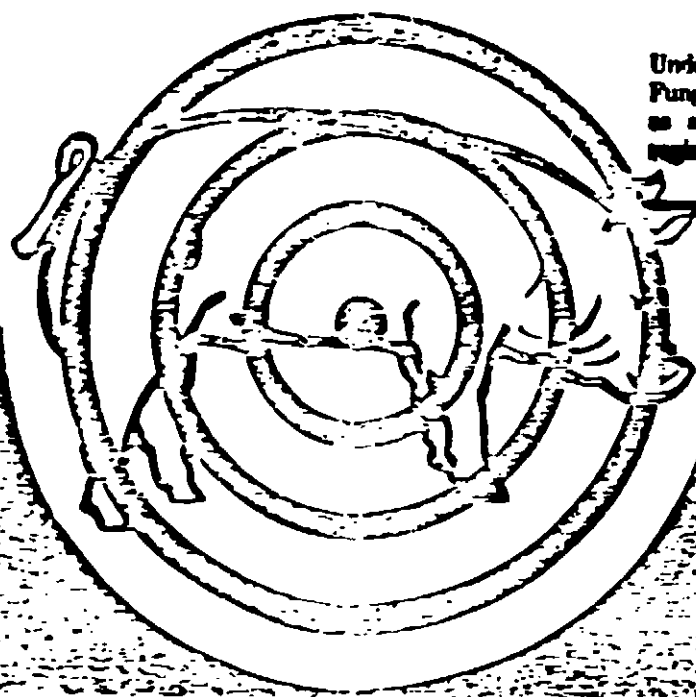

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- DO NOT apply Lindane where it will contaminate fruit or vegetables or where any livestock will graze.
- Do not treat sows within two weeks of farrowing nor for at least three weeks thereafter. Do not treat overheated or sick animals. Do not treat animals in cold stormy weather.
- Do not treat animals under three months of age
- Do not use on poultry, dogs, cats, other household pets, or humans.
- Do not use on dairy cattle.

Applicators must wear the following protective clothing during the application process: long-sleeved shirt, long pants, waterproof gloves, full foot covering and a head covering.

CONSULT STATE AGRICULTURAL EXPERIMENT STATION FOR RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USE UNDER LOCAL CONDITIONS.

FOR CONTROL OF TICKS AND LICE ON BEEF CATTLE AND HORSES AND FLEA COLLIE ON PIGS: LICE AND MANGE (SARCOPTIC AND PSOROFTIC) ON HOGS: Use at the rate of 1 pint in 50 gallons of water (0.05% Lindane) as a dip treatment. Do not dip within 60 days of slaughter. DO NOT USE ON DAIRY ANIMALS. Do not use on animals under three months old. Use half rate, 1/2 pint to 50 gallons of water on young animals but over three months old.

FOR CONTROL OF TICKS, LICE AND MANGE (SARCOPTIC AND PSOROFTIC) ON BEEF CATTLE, SHEEP AND GOATS: Use 1 pint of this product per 50 gallons of water as a dip treatment. Use at same rate for sheep after clipping. Repeat treatments at 14 day intervals as needed. Do not dip within 60 days of slaughter. DO NOT USE ON DAIRY ANIMALS. Do not use on animals under three months old.

DIPPING PRECAUTIONS: Do not use on animals under three months old. Dips for younger animals, but over three months old should be prepared at the rate of 1/2 pint to 50 gallons of water. Do not dip animals within 60 days of slaughter.

DO NOT use this product or its residues of in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) and the application of the Act. If you use more than 1000 lbs. of used dip solution per month or more than 1000 kg (2200 lbs.) of used dip solution in combination with other hazardous waste, the material must be treated as a hazardous waste subject to subpart C of RCRA. Any user who wishes to treat, store or dispose of hazardous waste must obtain a permit to serve as a hazardous waste facility pursuant to RCRA.

TICKS AND CHIGLIES ON VEGETATION: Lawns, recreation areas, campgrounds, golf courses. Mix 1 quart thoroughly in 25 gallons of water and apply at the rate of about 1 gallon to 1000 square feet. Cylindrical or knapsack type hand sprayers may be used over small areas, but power equipment will be most satisfactory for large acreages. Treat ground litter, soil and the lower parts of plants with this spray.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Keep product in original container, tightly closed. This product does not freeze or crystallize at storage temperatures of 0°F. or higher. It should be allowed to warm to at least 40°F., and then be agitated before use, if lindane crystals have precipitated out of solution at temperatures below 0°F.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact
