Throw Pac left untouched for 4 to 5 consecutive nights should be moved to a new location.

Bait should be placed 1/4 to 1/2 oz. (tablespoon) in shallow containers where mice or signs of mice have been seen. Bait stations at intervals of 8 to 10 feet are recommended. Assure an uninterrupted supply of bait for a period of not less than 10 days.
