DIRECTIONS FOR CONTROLLING NORWAY & ROOF

RATS:

Assure an uninterrupted supply of bait for a period of not less than 10 days and continue baiting until all signs of feeding have stopped.

In moderately infested locations at least 4 to 16 ozs. of RMC bait should be placed where rats feed, water, or travel, along walls, in corners, and concealed locations where they can feed unobserved. Each location should contain enough bait so that some will be left over the following morning.
