DIRECTIONS

FOR BURROWING GOPHERS: With the aid of a long-handled spoon, remove soft earth plug leading underground at a freshly thrown out mound of soil. Using the long-handled spoon, introduce 1/2 teaspoon bait as far down into the burrow system as possible. Close the opening to the surface, being careful not to allow loose dirt to cover the bait.

FOR THIRY-LINED GOPHERS (13-Lined Spermophile): 1/2 teaspoon bait should be scattered in the entrance of their burrows.
