USE DIRECTIONS AND PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Directions for Use: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use of any form of methomyl fly bait product around or inside homes, or any other place where children are likely to be present.

Use LURECTRON® SCATTERBAIT pellets around the following commercial areas only: commercial poultry houses, cattle barns, and feed lots, canneries, beverage producers, meat, poultry and food processing plants. Scatterbait pellets may also be used on walkways in caged layer houses.

For use as a Scatterbait: Scatter pellets at a rate of approximately 1/4 pound of pellets per 500 ft², maintaining a spacing of 1-2 inches between pellets. Do not leave pellets in piles.

For use as a paste: Mix 0.25 lb of Scatter-Bait with 4.0 oz. water, stir well and keep covered for a few hours. Apply the paste with a brush on walls, window sills, support beams, etc. where flies usually land.

For use in bait stations: Scatterbait pellets may be used in bait stations placed at least four (4) feet off the ground. One bait station for 500 square feet should provide control.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Methomyl is a cholinesterase inhibitor; atropine is antidotal.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to birds. Collect, cover or incorporate granules spilled on the soil surface. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES Permit. For guidance contact your Regional Office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. **Storage:** Store in a dry cool place inaccessible to children and pets. Always keep the containers closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
