Fatal if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves. Causes skin irritation. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Harmful if inhaled - avoid vapor or spray mist. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes. Wear face shield or goggles when handling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Brushing: apply liberally with brush or mop, flooding surface so as to fill completely all cross cuts, mortises, tenons, checks and other defects. After an interval of 24 hours, or after first application has dried, apply a second coat in the same manner. Open tank method or dipping: immerse the timber in a bath of creosote for two hours. After an interval of 24 hours or after first application has dried, repeat the operation.

Spraying: Spray with a spray gun or paint machine. Spraying effectively drives creosote into cracks and crevices but is not recommended in cold weather. After an interval of 24 hours or after first application has dried, apply a second coat in the same manner.

Two applications are essential for all material to be used under or lying on the ground. All wood to be treated should be completely peeled of bark. Do not dilute.

Close container after each use.

**STORAGE AND
DISPOSAL**

For best results store at temperatures above 50° F, but keep away from high temperature areas, sparks, fire or open flame. Creosote is a combustible liquid. To prevent container from rusting and leaking, do not store in a damp area. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

If container is leaking or the creosote is spilled, protect hands with rubber gloves and remove to outdoors. Cover spill with layer of sand or earth. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. Disposal must be in accordance with local, state and federal regulations.

Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.
