DIRECTIONS

RESTAURANTS, TAVERNS, HOTELS, AND INSTI-TUTIONS

For the sanitation of glasses, dishes, cooking utensils and bottles - clean with a solution of suitable detergent (hot soap) and rinse thoroughly with water, Sanitize by rinse or immersion in a solution of 1 oz. Q - K to 4 gallons of water, then air dry.

HOSPITALS

For general disinfection of floor, walls, furniture, sinks, both tubs, showers, toilet seats - first clean with a good detergent, rinse with water, then disinfect with Q - K 800 P.M. solution, (1 ounce per gallon of water)

FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS, CANNERS, MEAT PACKERS, BAKERS

Clean walls and floor with a good detergent solution rinse, then spray with Q - K at 800 P.P.M. soltuion. For equipment - wash thoroughly in suitable detergent, rinse, then drip or spray on Q - K sanitizing solution of 1 ounce to 4 gallons of water — air dry.


